YOUTH SERVICE WEEK - For a number of years the Martensdale Community Church has taken their youth on an early summer mission service trip to help a Bible camp prepare for the season. Several years ago, they chose Camp Appanoose to be their project focus. Not only do they come with a team of anxious volunteers, but they often fund the projects through a special coffee house event which they offer for the adults of the church. This year, along with a number of cleaning and repair projects, they began construction of a bridge across Battle Creek; they constructed a set of monkey bars; and then rebuilt the stairs on one of the entry doors. They also purchased and donated an institutional quality table tennis set which can also divide into two game tables. The camp ministry has been most blessed!

On Friday, after projects are completed, there is always time for some horseback riding and a few rounds of paintball. Under the direction of associate pastor, Daniel Moore, and about a half dozen adult volunteers, the group is led in times of Bible study and discipleship, coinciding with their projects of service.

ROCKY HIGH IN AUGUST - With camps now underway, it is hard to realize how quickly the summer flies by! There is still time to register for one of the Rocky High Camps. Two trips are planned this year for July 29th through August 7th. Both trips will follow the same trail plans but will function separately.

Rocky High I, July 29 – August 7, is for young persons, grades 7-12, who are ready for an adventure in the mountains. Approximately forty miles of backpacking in one of the most scenic places in North America, hikers will explore over half of the Rawah, a Colorado wilderness area where moose, elk, big horn sheep are among an abundance of wildlife. Crystal clear mountain streams, pristine lakes, rugged peaks all combine to make Rocky High an unforgettable adventure.

Rocky High II will follow a similar route on the same dates. Designed for young adults (18 and up), the second group will provide opportunity for developing friendships and shared experiences which could last a lifetime.
