


## HORSE CAMPS

## COWBOY CAMPS –entering 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>

**COWBOY I - June 14-17**

**COWBOY II – June 17-20**

Designed to be a beginner camp experience for boys and girls who will be entering the second or third grades. Hayrack rides, fishing, crafts, horses, gams, Bible Stories, fun songs, nature lessons, swimming and much more! Choose: June 14-17 (3 days); June 17-20 (2 days) or both camps (5 days).

## LEADERSHIP TRAINING Camps

For mature teens and young adults.

### LTC I – TRGR – May 31-June 6

This camp features a week of in depth Biblical education, designed to establish a firm foundation, for the mature teen or young adult, to think critically. While each session stands on its own, the entire curriculum is completed over three summers and provides participants with a rich overview of truth, forming a firm foundation for young adults who wish to make a difference in their world for Christ. Days are complete with great meals, several recreational activities and new friends. Adults and families may attend. Some families have used TRGR for a home school credit in Bible or theology. Bring a tent or RV and reserve space in our own Appanoose Village.

### LTC II – Camp Craft – June 7-13

Camp Craft, or staff training week, is also a practical leadership camp covering such areas as small group dynamics, spiritual formation, Biblical pedagogy, and recreational leadership. LTC II is offered without charge for those who apply and are available to work the entire summer. Younger participants will work as needed and will return home on the weekends. Volunteer adult counselors may also take this course free of charge.

SURF Club (Students United in Real Faith) grades 7-12 Gathering throughout the school year to stay connected and involved. Join us on Saturday evenings for a time of fun camp activities, building positive peer relationships and a time of practical Biblical

## ADVENTURE CAMPS for TEENS

### Iowa Teen Adventure – July 16-25

Teen Adventure Camp, for middle and older teens offers challenge and friendship in a fun environment. Bible Talks and small group interaction will engage teens in the Scriptures while addressing foundational issues of faith and life. Classic camp activities may include archery, riflery, barrel racing, swimming, canoeing, water skiing, and more. During the expedition phase participants may choose between several options. Each off grounds option will feature two nights of outpost camping.

#### Expedition Phase Options –

- Water Trek – Explore a scenic water trail from a canoe or kayak. Water navigation lessons offered on Monday.
- Horse Trek – Choose this trek on horseback for a couple of days of trail riding. Experience the beauty of back country trails along with the companionship of a camp horse. Horse campers will return to base at night.
- Bike Trek – Bring your bike along and experience some of the highlights of the hundreds of miles of central Iowa's bike trails. (A limited number of loaner bikes available.)

**IA Teen Adventure Camp begins at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 16 and ends at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 25.**

### BOUNDARY WATERS ADVENTURE CAMP – July 27-August 5

Beginning on grounds, participants will experience the magnificent beauty of the northern Boreal Forests. At the end of the Gunflint Trail, campers will participate in a brief skill enhancing canoe course before venturing out as a group to explore a world of lakes, rivers and forests, just below the Canadian border. Bible studies parallel experiences along the water trail.

### ROCKY HIGH ADVENTURE CAMP for Young Adults Dates TBA

Beginning on grounds, participants will experience the magnificent beauty of the Rocky Mountains in a small group led by our experienced staff. Golden aspens, alpine forests, big game, crystal clear streams, fragile tundra and so much more will accent these ten days, filled with friendship, spiritual encouragement, and shared challenges. ### ROCKY HIGH ON HORSEBACK July 27-August 5

Ride trails through some of America's most spectacular scenery, even above the tree line. You may see elk, moose, big horn sheep, or any number of other wildlife. Modest pre-trip equestrian skills are desirable. Guides and extra pack animals are provided, along with camp staff. Grades 7-12.
